What We've Done



Our portfolio of work for a large number of clients is extensive. Recently, for Petrofac at the Shetland Gas Plant we provided civil teams who carried out track works and road works and provided utilities and crane pads; environmental teams who looked after water management, COSHH and emergency response in the event of a spill; spoil management – haulage and disposal of material at our Staney Hill landfill facility; and plant which included two 55-tonne mobile cranes, 14 excavators (0.75-36 tonnes), dumpers, rollers and telehandlers.



What We've Done

We also supplied quarried aggregates for crane pads, roads, pipe bedding and foundations; fuel to plant equipment on site; and traffic co-ordination and management services to organize and control the movement of large, pre-fabricated modules and plant items.

In addition, in relation to the Shetland Gas Plant we have built a large electricity substation for SSE incorporating a framed building with sheet cladding.

Under sub-contract to Morrison Construction, we have also built a park-and-ride car park at Sella Ness for BP staff unable to park at Sullom Voe Terminal. This was due to the transportation of large gas plant modules from the construction jetty to the site. In addition, we built eight rock-armoured emergency laybys along the access road to SVT.

One of our biggest clients has been Lerwick Port Authority, for whom we have carried out a series of projects over the years, including reclamation of a large area of land between Shetland Transport and Shetland Catch and the construction of a new dockside on tubular piles with a suspended concrete deck.
